

Information regarding conformity with the demands in the REACH Directive

Thank You very much for Your enquiry concerning Reach and it´s consequence to Your business with PcP Corp A/S

The EU regulations No. 1907/2006 of December 2006 regarding registration, evaluation, approval and restriction of chemicals (REACH) entered into force June 1. 2007.

We hereby confirm that PcP Corp A/S. always follow the latest update to regulations No. 1907/2006 of December 2006, and the ever-increasing number of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) in accordance with article 59 of the REACH regulation.

PCP Corp A/S Is always updated according to the latest update on the SVHC candidate list. All product/substances are registered in Eco Online. With Eco Online we are always aware of chemical product containing SVHC substances. In addition to SVHC tracking we are also aware by using Eco Online of any updates of REACH annex XIV (authorization list) and annex XVII (restriction list) that also include tracking of substance and products that can be important to react for regarding cancer.

PcP. A/S is primarily a user of chemicals for lubrication and release agents in connection with the manufacture of our products (downstream user).

We have a regular contact with our suppliers of those chemicals to ensure that our supplies meets the quality and environmental demands including the requirement of pre-registration of chemicals so that the necessary corrective actions might be taken.

Products supplied by us are produced in compliance with article no. 3 in the REACH regulations. The products are not meant to release or will release (Article 7, part 1; Article 7, part 2).

As a result, our products are not covered of a registration, a notification or informative demands through the REACH regulations.

Compliance with the demands in REACH mentioned above does not restrict the quality and the technical characteristics in our products.
